In his career as a judge Karl decided thousands of civil and criminal cases and gained expertise- inter alia - in all areas of commercial and corporate law. After retirement from the Court of Appeal in Munich he has focused his interests on international private law and expanded his practice as an independent arbitrator both in domestic and international fora.

For decades he has been teaching and training lawyers and judges in Eastern Europe, the Middle East and North Africa. He also consulted the Rwandan government in re-establishing the judiciary after genocide ravished the country and recently advised the administration of the Autonomous Region Kurdistan (Irak) in a project to modernize enforcement proceedings.

He is the co-author of commentaries to the German law on limited liability companies (GmbHG) and on the compensation procedure for minority shareholders (SpruchG).
