



Ivana has been with the ICC International Court of Arbitration as a Deputy Counsel since February 2015. For over a year, Ivana supervised arbitration proceedings from France, Switzerland, Benelux as well from the regions of West Africa and Middle-East under the 1998 and 2012 ICC Rules of Arbitration and the ICC Rules as Appointing Authority. These transnational disputes were both commercial and investment by nature and stemmed from different economic sectors such as corporate finance, telecommunications and the pharmaceutical industry. Since June 2016, she administers arbitrations from the region of Eastern Europe and specializing mainly in energy and construction sectors.
